### BARCELONA

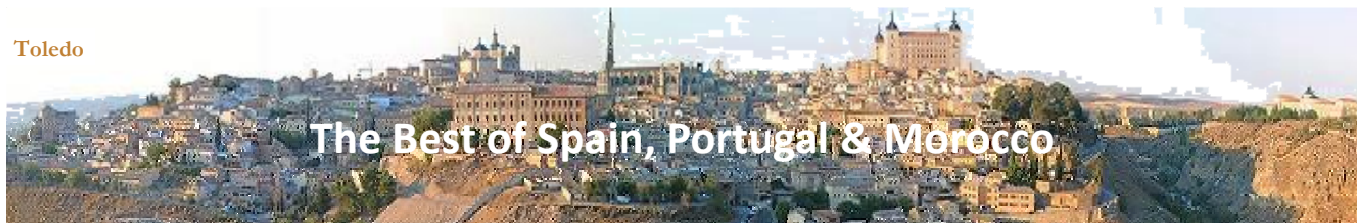

### SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

The capital of Galicia which has UNESCO World Heritage designation, has some of Europe's best conserved monuments. This is the city, the final stop on the Camino de Santiago. Enjoy a walking tour through the streets of the old quarters, and visit the Cathedral, a legendary center of pilgrimage where the crypt of the apostle St. James is to be found.

### CÓRDOBA

The historic centre of the ancient capital of the Umayyad Caliphate has the UNESCO World Heritage designation, and this is not only on account of the Great Mosque. Enjoy a panoramic walking tour by the old Jewish Quarter, and visit the magnificent Mosque, one of the most important in the Islamic World, built during the time of the Caliphs, with its magnificent forest of marble columns in whose center is a Christian Cathedral.

### GRANADA

Visit the spectacular complex of the Alhambra and Generalife, former residence of the Arab kings, with its fantasy of patios, arches, gardens and fountains. It was the largest political and aristocratic centre of the Moslem West. The Palace premises comprise courtyards and fountains, as well as, the Nasrid buildings that served as living quarters for the monarchs.



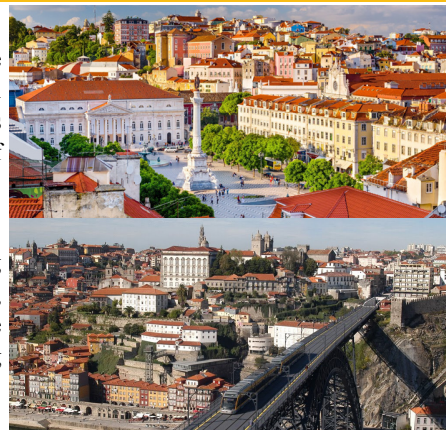
## Portugal

### LISBON

Lisbon, a city of contrasts, offering so much to discover and surprise, still maintains the marks of its early history along with a rich cultural mix being one of the most beautiful capitals of Europe. Enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of the capital of Portugal which is located at the mouth of river Tagus: You will see the Moorish Alfama Quarter, Tower of Belem, Monument to Navigators, etc. and the inside of the Monastery of St. Geronimus.

### PORTO

## Morocco

Marrakesh comprises an old fortified city packed with vendors and their stalls (in the medina), bordered by modern neighborhoods, the most prominent of which is Gueliz. Visit the Saadian Tombs and Summer Royal Palace. Panoramic city tour of this Imperial city to discover Koutoubia Tower and the impressive Djemaa el Fna square.

### RABAT

The capital city of Morocco, is also one of the country's four imperial cities, is located on the Atlantic coast at the mouth of the Wadi Bou Regreg, opposite the city of Salé. Enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of this interesting city, where you will visit the Mohamed V mausoleum with the Hassan Tower and the Royal Palace (from outside).

### Day 1 | ORIGIN - MADRID

### Day 2 | MADRID (Sightseeing City Tour)

**Buffet Breakfast.** Today you will discover the Spanish capital, a fantastic city being one of the greatest cultural hubs in the world. Fine restaurants and tapas bars are plentiful around the city to give you a real taste of Spain with hundred-year-old establishments and Michelin-star restaurants for a real romantic dinner. Near the plaza Mayor is the area known as the old aristocratic center where the jewel in the crown is the Royal Palace, an imposing building, whose works began in 1738, and was completed in 1764, featuring a mixture of Baroque and Classicist styles. Besides it, is Plaza de Oriente, the Teatro Real Opera house, and the cathedral of La Almudena. During approximately 2:30 hours, You will admire Madrid's most important buildings, avenues and squares: Gran Via, Plaza de España, Moncloa University Area, Calle Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Puerta de Alcalá, the Bullring, Columbus square, Real Madrid F.C Stadium Santiago Bernabeu. **Overnight in Madrid.**
